- Entry fees are \$15 per dog per run**

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Agility trial is **open** to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP number. Mixed Breed dogs that are registered with AKC may enter. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate.

AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each jump height of each class and division. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs that receive a qualifying score. MACH rosette and bar will be offered to any dog/handler team that completes their title at these trials. New title ribbons will be offered to any dog/handler team that completes their title at these trials. No unclaimed awards or ribbons will be mailed.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without dogs, prior to the start of each class before or after the Judge's briefing. There will be no equipment familiarization for Novice. No excessive training or corrections on the grounds will be allowed.

A WARM UP jump area consisting of one regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors. This is not to be used as for training.
