IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT OBEDIENCE CLASSES

JUMP HEIGHT ORDER

Entries will be arranged in ascending jump height order starting with 22 inches. Therefore, jump height is required on the entry form. We will attempt to contact you if your entry is missing this information. Failing that, we will place your dog based on its breed and a typical height for that breed. Please make our trial secretary's job easier and provide your jump height. We will make every effort to separate multiple dogs being shown by the same handler, even if it means putting one dog out of jump height order, but that will be the only exception to jump height order.

UDX CLASS

Dogs entered in the UDX class will be entered in both Open B and Utility B, and the combined fee for the two classes must be paid. Once the limit has been reached in either Open B or the Utility B class, the UDX class will be considered closed. Any subsequent entries for the class will be unacceptable in their entirety.

OPTIONAL TITLING CLASSES

A description of the optional titling classes **Graduate Novice** and **Graduate Open** may be found in **Chapter 7** of the "Obedience Regulations".

A description of the optional titling class **Versatility** may be found in **Chapter 8** of the "Obedience Regulations".

DESCRIPTION OF VETERANS CLASSES

Veterans Novice: A description of the requirements for Veterans Novice may be found in **Chapter 14, section 6** of the "Obedience Regulations" where it is listed simply as "Veterans Class".

Veterans Open: The Veterans Open class will be for dogs that have an obedience title and are at least 7 years old on the date of the trial. The exercises will be performed and judged as in the Open class with two exceptions. 1) The handler may choose any jump height for the Retrieve Over High Jump exercise from 4" to 36". The Broad Jump will be set at two times the height used for the High jump. 2) There will be no group Long Sit exercise. The point total for the group Long Down exercise will be adjusted to 60 pts so that the total points available for the class remains at 200 points. Dogs entered in Veterans Open may be entered in another class or classes.

Veterans Utility: The Veterans Utility class will be for dogs that have an obedience title and are at least 7 years old on the date of the trial. The exercises will be performed and judged as in the Utility class with one exception. The handler may choose any jump height for the Directed Jumping exercise from 4" to 36". Dogs entered in Veterans Utility may be entered in another class or classes.
